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### JOHANNESBURG

**PRE TOUR | OPTIONAL – SOWETO TOUR | Net cost R 2,720.00 net / per person from 4 pax minimum**

**08h30:** Meet your tour guide at the hotel reception and depart on a full day discovery of Soweto, start the day with a visit of the Apartheid museum.

#### **Apartheid Museum |**

This extraordinarily powerful museum, certain to become one of Johannesburg's most important tourist attractions, has become an obligatory stop for tourists and residents alike. The Museum, with its large blown-up photographs, metal cages and numerous monitors recording continuous replays of apartheid scenes set in a double volume ceiling, concrete and red brick walls and grey concrete floor, is next to the Gold Reef City Casino, five kilometres south of the city centre. The museum's director, Christopher Till, says: "It is appropriate that the first apartheid museum in South Africa should open in Johannesburg, where at the turn of the century there was a convergence of people for a range of different reasons.

Continue to Soweto (SOuth WEstern TOWnship), the largest black residential area in South Africa. Highlights of this tour included are: two Nobel Prize winners previous residences, Visit of the Hector Peterson Memorial (No entry) & Chris Hani Baragwanath Hospital and the famous Vilakazi street. Guests will also visit the Mandela House.

#### **Voortrekker Monument |**

The majestic Voortrekker Monument, situated in a nature reserve in Pretoria, is a unique Monument that commemorates the Pioneer history of Southern Africa and the history of the Afrikaner. Its stunning setting has become a popular venue to tie the knot.

The Voortrekker Monument is more than just a heritage conservation site. It is a cultural home for the Afrikaner. It is a beacon of hope that you can see from any direction in Pretoria. The Voortrekker Monument provides an opportunity for the public to learn more about the Afrikaner's story, from the Great Trek to the Anglo-Boer War and more. The monument tells a story of heroism, perseverance, and a vision for the future so that we can be where we are today.

The Voortrekker Monument today is the most visited heritage site of its kind in Gauteng and one of the top ten cultural historical visitor attractions in the country. It was the first site to be graded a National Heritage Site in Pretoria.

Continue in the city of Pretoria through a panoramic drive and discover the Union Buildings

## CAPE TOWN

### **Table Mountain – *weather permitting* |**

The best views of Cape Town are seen from the top of Table Mountain. The Cableway summit is under 10 minutes and the cable car's rotating floor ensures that all passengers have an aerial view of the city. Table Mountain is a sandstone plateau rising up above the Cape Flats. The top is approximately 3km wide, and at its highest point, Maclears Beacon, rises to 1085m. Over the centuries it has become one of South Africa's most famous landmarks. The steep cliffs and rocky outcrops of the mountain play home to a number of plants and animals. (Weather permitting)

#### **Three Bay Helicopter Scenic Tour – 24 min |**

You will truly uncover Cape Town's multi-faceted character on the Three Bays Tour. Starting at the V&A Waterfront, this tour takes you over the pristine outer Cape Peninsula, then along Table Mountain and the Twelve Apostles mountain range. You'll see the Atlantic Seaboard's unspoilt white beaches unfold in front of your eyes as you fly along coastal Clifton, Camps Bay and Llandudno and, if you're lucky, whales may welcome you en-route to Hout Bay's lush greenery and aquamarine waters. Then, your flight will head inland, over Cape Town's southern suburbs before the glistening False Bay appears on the other edge of the Peninsula. Here you will get a chance to view Fish Hoek and Muizenberg from above. On the equally spectacular return flight along the Southern Seaboard, you'll get to take in the sky-high view of Cape Town's bustling City Bowl before landing back at NAC Helicopters at the V&A Waterfront.
