Day 1: Wednesday, May 7, 2025 - Arrival in Sydney

Taxi/Uber are readily available at Sydney's Kingston Smith International Airport (SYD). An Uber X ride runs about 50 AUD (roughly \$32 USD) and Uber Premier (the Australian equivalent to Uber Black) around 100 AUD (\$64 USD).

For those who booked Seabourn's Litchfield National Park Tour, you will Taxi/Uber to the pier, located at Darwin Port Cruise Ship Terminal's Fort Hill Wharf, 1 Anchorage Court. Your tour

leaves at **9:15am** and we recommend arriving at the pier by **9am** at the latest. It takes about 15 minutes to travel from the Hilton Darwin to the Cruise Ship Terminal.

9:30am Meet in Hilton Darwin Lobby with your Luggage and load onto Motor Coach

9:45am Transfer to Darwin Cruise Terminal

10am Drop off Luggage and Check-in for the Cruise

Approx 4pm Seabourn Pursuit is ready to board
